Frank Tony "Bear" Evans, 71, of Wall Twp. passed away on Tuesday June 4, 2019 at Monmouth Medical Center, Long Branch. Bear was born in Livorno, Italy and was raised in Long Branch. After graduating from Long Branch High School he entered the United States Navy, where he served from 1966 to 1970. Bear retired in 2008 after 43 years as a foreman with New Jersey American Water in Shrewsbury.
