Philip, or Phil, as he was known to some, was born at Monmouth medical Center in Long Branch to Bernard and Rosa-Lee Schwartz, and grew up in the Wanamassa section of Ocean. His father had a luggage store for many years on Cookman Avenue in Asbury Park. Phil attended Rutgers University, studying accounting, but left to attend to his ailing mother, after losing his father at a young age.

Phil loved sports, particularly basketball, and was particularly fascinated with the history of sports, facts and figures, which led him to amass a great collection of old sports broadcasts. He could be eccentric at times, and had his quirks, but whoever knew him knew he had a huge heart.
