Alice Fitzpatrick Mauriello, aged 98, passed away peacefully with family by her side on October 1, 2024 in Tinton Falls, New Jersey.

Born on August 24, 1926, in Jersey City, Alice was known for her dedication to family; her selfless and compassionate nature; her intelligence, warmth, humor, and beauty; and her wide circle of friends.

Alice grew up in St. Aedan's parish and attended St. Aedan's parochial school and St. Aloysius High School. She graduated from the Jersey City Medical Center School of Nursing in 1947. She cherished her role as a nurse, a profession she set aside to devote herself to raising her six children. Her Catholic faith was a source of comfort and strength throughout her life.

Alice was active in the parents' associations of St. Aloysius Grammar School, the Academy of St. Aloysius and St. Peter's Prep, all in Jersey City, as well as in the Hudson County Medical Society Auxiliary. Alice loved to host family gatherings at her home in Jersey City and Lavallette, was a voracious reader, and relished the challenge of the New York Times crossword puzzles.
