Anne P. Caslin (nee Sharkey), age 86, passed away peacefully on Saturday. Born in Urlaur, Co. Mayo, Ireland to George and Winifred Sharkey. After immigrating to the U.S. in 1948 Anne became active in the Mayo Ladies and was Captain of her camogie team. She was a 70+ year member of the Pioneer Total Abstinence Association of the Sacred Heart. Anne met her husband Stephen Caslin at Gaelic Park in the Bronx where they were active in Irish sports and spent many dedicated years in the Co. Roscommon Society and AOH. Anne retired from Abraham & Strauss in 1984 and moved back to Ireland with her husband to her family home in Urlaur Abbey. Anne was predeceased by her husband Stephen.
