Anthony Joseph Pagano, 81, of Tinton Falls, passed away Sunday, January 2, 2022 at Ocean Medical Center, Brick. He was born on July 5, 1940 in Brooklyn, New York and moved to Tinton Falls in 1986. Anthony was an Army veteran serving in Berlin, Germany. Upon returning to civilian life, Anthony worked as an electrician before joining the New York Transit Authority where he retired in 1995. After retirement, he worked at Home Depot in West Long Branch.

In his free time, Anthony enjoyed fishing with his brothers and family off the shores of Long Island. Whether watching on TV or in person, he was an Avid NY Yankees Fan. He could often be found watching John Wayne movies and westerns or working on his vegetable garden. Anthony treasured the time he spent watching his grandsons participate in their various sports and activities over the years.
