August 31, 1940 - July 19, 2013

Charles A. Stoneham, Jr., 72, Ret. Eatontown Police Lieutenant, passed away suddenly on Friday July 19, 2013 at Monmouth Medical Center, Long Branch. Charles was born in Bayonne; he lived and worked most of his life in the Borough of Eatontown. He was a veteran of the United States Navy serving from 1963 to 1967. He began his career with the borough of Eatontown Police Department in 1968 working 27 years before retiring as lieutenant in 1994. He was a life member of PBA local 305. He was a life member of the Eatontown Fire Dept. Engine, Truck & Hose Company#1, Ex-Captain and Life Member of the Eatontown First Aid Squad and a member of the B.P.O.E. Eatontown Lodge #2402. He also was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2226 in Oakhurst.

Charles was predeceased by his parents Charles and Hilda Stoneham; his sister; Patricia Nemeth and brother Clinton Stoneham. He is survived by his wife of 45 years, Darlene Stoneham, his daughter Shannon Gaetano, Son-In-Law, Anthony (Bubba) Gaetano, Grandchildren: Danielle, Isabella & Angelina and his brother Thomas and wife Janet Stoneham.
