



## Costas T. Lymberis

March 29, 1944 - December 28, 2020

Costas T. Lymberis, 76, of Holmdel, NJ passed away peacefully on Monday December 28, 2020 at Bayshore Medical Center, Holmdel, surrounded by his two daughters.

Born in Athens, Greece, Costas graduated from Anargyrios-Korialenios, a boarding school on the island of Spetses. He then moved to the US, where he received his Bachelor of Science degree in Physics from UCLA in 1967 and his MS in Physics from California State University in 1970 where he was awarded the Sigma-Pi-Sigma Physics Honor Society distinction. He attended UC Berkeley for PhD studies in Biophysics. Costas worked as an Environmental Engineer, Corrosion Specialist, for the United States Army Corps of Engineers for 21 years, when he retired in September 2013. He was also a professor of Physics and Math at Middlesex County College and taught a Graduate course in Corrosion at Stevens Institute of Technology. He was recognized for his 40 year sustained contribution to NACE International and to the field of corrosion science and engineering. He also served as Treasurer of the Metropolitan Engineers Societies Council (MESOC) New York Section and NACE.

Among his proudest achievements was the academic scholarship of his two daughters, who both studied engineering as a result of his mentoring and encouragement. He is survived by his wife Dionisia Lymberis, who resides in

Holmdel, his daughter, Dr. Stella Lymberis, son in law, Dr. Vassilis Latoussakis and two grandchildren, Olga and Michalis, who reside in New York City, and his daughter Cleo Lymberis who resides in Athens, Greece. He is also survived by his sister Dr. Maria Lymberis, who resides in Los Angeles, CA.
