David was born on February 5, 1937, in Trenton, New Jersey to Leonard and Ruth Relles.

David was preceded in death by his wife of 47 years, Lynne Gatta Relles, and is survived by their daughter Elinor Tappé and grandchildren David Corbin and Ovi Tappé.
