

## Donald E. Markel

October 4, 1931 - August 30, 2009

Donald E. Markel, 77, of Eatontown, passed away peacefully on Sunday, August 30, 2009 at home. He will be remembered as a devoted husband, loving father and cherished grandfather.

Donald was born and raised in Niagara Falls, N.Y. He proudly served as a Sergeant First Class in the US Army during the Korean and Vietnam wars and retired after 22 years of service. He received multiple commendations including the National Defense Service Medal w/First Oak Leaf Cluster; Korean Service Medal; Good Conduct Medal; Vietnam Service Medal and the Bronze Star Medal. During his military service he learned electronics and served as an instructor in the US Army Signal School and after retiring from the military in 1971 put his knowledge and love of teaching to good use as an Assoc. Prof at DeVry University. Donald was instrumental in developing a night program to provide access to education for students unable to attend school during daytime hours. He managed this program for many years. During his time at DeVry, he was recognized for the development of Electronics Work Bench Software utilized for their labs and classes. He retired in 2002 after 30 years of dedicated service.

Surviving is his beloved wife of 48 years, Frances, His children; Michael and his wife Beth of East Brunswick; Lori of Eatontown; Bonny and her husband David Laub of Edison, six grandchildren; Stephen and Amy Markel, Anthony and Lisa Scoppettuolo, David and Rachel Laub. Also surviving is his sister; Joan Colangelo and sister in law Amor Markel as well as many nieces and

nephews.

He will be greatly missed by his friends, family, students and everyone who knew him. He was loved and admired by all the lives he touched.

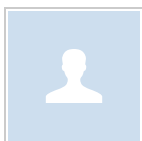

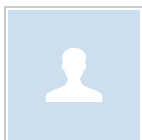
