Dorothy “Dotty” Lowe, Age 80

Dorothy “Dotty” (Toner) Lowe, 80, entered into eternal rest on Tuesday, February 4, 2014 at Jersey Shore Medical Center, surrounded by her family. And, in those final moments with them, Dotty found her peace.

Born in Brooklyn on November 7, 1933, Dotty lived almost the entirety of her life in Brooklyn. She stubbornly moved to the Jersey Shore only a few years ago when her health began to fail so as to be closer to her family. Dotty was deeply devoted to Saint Anthony, and worshiped the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Her family lovingly experienced the peace with Christ she achieved as she was anointed by Father Mike.

Dotty was by no means a homebody. She loved to be out and about catching a bus or train to anywhere at any time of the day or night; that was the beauty of her beloved New York. Dotty could be found at OTB playing the horses, at

(her one beloved New Jersey destination) Atlantic City until her moneys ran dry, or making crafts, costumes, or hanging wallpaper. Dotty and her sister, Helen, are “wallpapering” in Heaven as her brother-in-law, Junior, holds and lifts the ladder for them.
