Edward C Bullwinkel II, 73, of Eatontown, passed away Saturday, December 26, at home with his family at his side. Born and raised in Brooklyn, N.Y., he moved to N.J. in the mid 1950;s and has lived in Eatontown for over 48 years with his family. He attended Brooklyn Polytechnic Institute and graduated with a degree in Electrical Engineering and worked for the United States Government for 35 years before retiring in 1998. 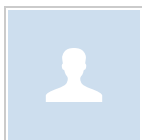
