Edward O. Clark, 84, of Eatontown, passed away Thursday March 5, at St. Barnabas Hospice and Palliative Care Center @ MMC, Long Branch. Born in Long Branch, he was a lifelong resident of Eatontown. Edward was employed by the Central Jersey Bank and Trust Company as a Vice President and Manager of the Eatontown and Fort Monmouth offices of the bank. Edward served on the Borough Council in Eatontown for six years and for a time was President of the council and police commissioner. He was a past president of the Mid-Jersey Chapter of the American Institute of Banking. He was a past member of the Eatontown Lions Club and one of the initial members. Edward was also on the board that founded the Senior Citizens Home on Wyckoff road that was dedicated in October of 1981.
