Erin Kasper, 38, of Bradley Beach, NJ died of complications from Covid-19 at Hackensack Meridian Health Jersey Shore University Medical Center, Neptune City, NJ on Monday, January 11, 2021. Her loving dad and best friend, Jack Kasper was able to spend time with her during her final hours.

Erin was raised in West Windsor, NJ, lived in Bradley Beach, NJ and she recently moved into her own home in Avenel, NJ. Erin was very proud of this opportunity! Erin was a communicant of St. Teresa of Calcutta Parish, Bradley Beach. She was a graduate of West Windsor-Plainsboro High School South.

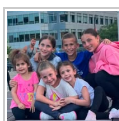
