



Eugene Carrino

January 7, 1923 - March 3, 2015

Eugene Carrino, 92, of Tinton Falls, passed away peacefully on March 3, 2015 after a short illness.

Eugene was born in Brooklyn, New York, and was employed by the New York City Board of Education for more than 40 years. A carpenter by trade, he was a fine craftsman and furniture maker. After relocating to New Jersey in 1981, he served as president of the Board of Directors and head of front door security at Riverview Towers for 23 years. He has resided at Seabrook Village in Tinton Falls since 2004.

As a parishioner of St. Mary Mother of Jesus Parish in Brooklyn, Eugene, who was a high school athlete, coached the track team for many years. His great joy was in mentoring the young team members, many of whom stayed in touch with him throughout their lives.

Eugene loved people and was a devoted husband and father. He was often seen around Red Bank during his daily five-mile walks which he continued into his eighties. He knew everyone in town, and his family often jokingly called him the unofficial “mayor of Red Bank.”

Eugene was predeceased by his wife, Eleanor, and son, Bill of St. Petersburg, Florida. He is survived by his daughter, Karen Muessig, her husband, Jack,

and their son, Danny. He will be missed by his friends and family who loved him dearly.

Visitation will be on Saturday, March 7, 2015 at Bongarzone Funeral Home, 2400 Shafto Road, Tinton Falls, from 2 to 4pm. Entombment and committal service will be held on Monday March 9, 2015 at St. Magdalen de Pazzi Mausoleum in Flemington.
