He was born Geoffrey Kyle Hart in Lawrence, Kansas on January 23, 1986 to Jonathan Hart and Bonnie Dale Campbell. He departed this life February 27, 2025 in Vineland, NJ.

Two things Goddy loved beyond measure: Music and his "Mini-me", his daughter, Faith Aaliyah. In fact when he and some of his siblings were little kids, they landed parts in the movie, *The Preacher's Wife*, right alongside Whitney Houston and Courtney Vance, singing with the other kids in the choir.

That might have been his only film but not the end of his singing. No, he kept on singing and as a sophomore at Monmouth Regional High school he sang his way to being named Mr. Monmouth Regional. And the next year he sang his way to the little again. He loved music and singing made him happy. And he kept it going on. If he wasn't singing something, he was writing something to sing or to rap. Or he was just coming up with the most outrageous scenarios and telling them to you with a straight face.

After graduating in 2004, he kept singing and finding ways to make music and share it wherever he could. Later that year, he and 3 friends formed the 732

Boyz: Brandon Shur-Shot; LT Solo; Dre-Nagi Lee and Goddy- The Nomad. They performed in several local venues including The Brighton Bar in Long Branch as well as locations in North Jersey and New York City.

Things he loved: Laughter, Long walks in nature, animals, especially Bentley, the family dog, and everything with Faith including walking, playing, talking, going to the library to read and bring books home. And he was a dreamer, always imagining new sounds and creating them, thinking about the next great inspiration.

He leaves to mourn his passing, his daughter Faith Aliah Hart and her mother, Rachel Ebner of Eatontown, his mother, Bonnie Dale Campbell of Oceanport, his father Jonathan Hart of Easton, PA, his paternal grandmother, Gloria Hart of Delaware, his sister Amia Marie Hart of Oceanport, his brothers, Jonathan and Desmond Hart, Lawrence Douglas Pulliam Jr., and Everett Carlton Sarter, his aunt Dawn Campbell of Portsmouth, Virginia and his cousin Ariel Cambell-Mohamed of Portsmouth, Virginia.
