Gina Marie Delutis, 52, of Tinton Falls, NJ passed away on Tuesday March 12, 2019 surrounded by her loving family after a 15 year long battle with breast cancer.

Gina was born in Newark to John and Marie Petito, and grew up in Colonia, NJ with her four siblings. After moving to Tinton Falls, NJ in 1998, Gina decided to be a stay at home mom and raise her boys. There was nothing she enjoyed more than a day at the beach with her children and friends. She played an active role in the Tinton Falls community and she was very involved in school activities and sporting events.

Gina is predeceased by her father, John T. Petito. She is survived by her beloved husband of 26 years Tony Delutis; her sons AJ and Brett Delutis; her mother Marie Petito (nee Mirandi); and her four siblings Maria Horvath (Zoltan), Terri Bernaski (John), George Petito (Laura), and John Petito. She is also survived by many nieces and nephews, and two grandnephews.
