Glenn Allen Arthur, 65, of Tinton Falls, NJ, passed away peacefully at his home on Saturday, December 5th, 2020. Glenn worked as a Systems Technician for Verizon for 40 years, an advocate for scuba diving, and a Veteran of the US Air Force.

Glenn was born in Jersey City and grew up in Pompton Plains, NJ. After meeting his wife, Rebecca, they moved to Tinton Falls in 1993 and later welcomed their daughter, Jennifer.

He was an avid scuba diver, proudly representing the recreational diving community as longtime Chairman of the New Jersey Council of Diving Clubs. He enjoyed reading science fiction books and spending time with his family. In his younger years, Glenn was a proud third-generation Firefighter riding with the Pequannock Township Fire Department Company # 1 and was a member of the Pequannock Township First Aid Squad. He also proudly served in the US Air Force and New York Air National Guard.

Glenn was predeceased by his parents, Lewis E. and Dorothy Arthur. He is survived by his beloved wife of 28 years, Rebecca; daughter Jennifer and her

fiancé Andrew Dinunno; sisters Janis Arthur and Pam Banks; nephews Parker Traynor and Matthew Vanderberg and niece Erin Vanderberg.

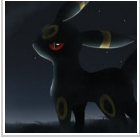
