



## Glover Leon Hill Jr.

November 6, 1931 - March 8, 2024

Glover L. Hill, Jr. (AKA Bugs, GL, or Bishop)

Born November 6, 1931, in Sheffield, Alabama, the oldest of three children whom God placed in the trusted care of Glover and Marie Hill. Attended public schools in Tennessee, Kentucky, and Alabama. Graduated high school in Sheffield, Alabama, in 1949. Received an undergraduate degree (BS) from North Carolina Central University in 1953. Enlisted and served in the US Army Medical Corp (1953). On May 15, 1954, he married his college sweetheart, Verdelle McKinney, just one week prior to beginning a tour of duty in Hokkaido, Japan. Received an Honorable Discharge in 1956. He and Verdelle then moved to her hometown in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. Glover then completed training for certification in Radiologic Technology at Kate Bitting Reynolds Memorial Hospital, School of Radiological Technology, Winston Salem, North Carolina in 1958 and received national certification by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (ARRT) the same year.

His professional career began at Kate Bitting Reynolds Memorial in 1958 where he was employed after Radiology School graduation and remained for the next fifteen years. During this period, he held positions as Staff Technologist, Chief Technologist/Director School of Radiologic Technology, and Chief Technologist/Administrative Assistant. In 1973 he accepted a position with Columbia University at its Harlem Hospital Center Affiliation, New

York, New York. The next twenty-seven years of his career was in the Department of Radiology at Harlem Hospital as Senior Associate Director for Administration. During his years at Harlem, I was able to accomplish many of his goals. Glovers dream to start a school for Radiologic Technologists was realized in 1990. Ten years later two of the graduating students received the 1st and 2nd highest grades on the national certification test.

During his years of employment, he received many awards and certificates. The most significant was the American Hospital Radiology Administrators NYCOMED Award for Excellence. The second was an Appreciation Award from the Faculty and Students of the School of Radiologic Technology, Harlem Hospital Center; the award states "Your Dream, Our Future". On October 9, 2009, he was presented a plaque that designated me as founder of the School of Radiologic Technology at Harlem Hospital.
