HELEN VERONICA NAGLE (née Leahy), passed away 15 February 2021, shortly after her 91st birthday, following lingering complications from a fall. Born in Manhattan on 27 January 1930, she grew up in Long Island City, Queens, NY. She married a Queens boy, Eugene Michael Nagle on 3 May 1951 in Manhattan. A few years later, they left New York City and relocated to Monmouth County to raise their four children, living in both Red Bank and Middletown, NJ.

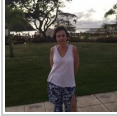
