James Edward Bell, 63, of Lakewood, NJ died August 27, 2016 at Monmouth Medical Center in Lakewood, NJ. James was a musician who started playing professional bass guitar in his late teens. He toured the country in various club bands until he transitioned to working as a live sound mixer at the renowned punk –rock club Madam Wong’s West. Subsequent to that he began working in recording studios in Los Angeles with such renowned music producers as Bob Gaudio of the Four Seasons and Jersey Boys fame. In 1989 Jim transitioned to working with sound in the television industry starting with the re-release of the original Dragnet series starring Jack Webb. From there he began work on the Rescue 911 show with William Shatner. During this time he also wrote music for a few independent bands in Los Angeles.

James is survived by his sister Dianne Talbot and her husband Herbert (Chip) Talbot of Brielle and his former wife Sherron Bell of Whitby Island, Washington.
