James Lockett Malony passed away on March 31, 2014. He was a graduate of West Point and a veteran of WWII. James served as an infantry unit commander in 1945 in the Philippines and Japan. He was a captain in the First Cavalry Division, Seventh Regiment. Upon his return to the US, he started his own consulting company, serving US clients in Europe, West Africa, South America and Russia. He continued to serve the United States in providing training services. He authored two published books.
