John Robert (Bob) Haney, 86, of West Long Branch, NJ, passed away peacefully on December 3rd with his family by his side.

Bob was born June 25, 1928 in Pittsburgh, PA to John and Mary (Walters) Haney. He grew up in Aliquippa, PA and continued to follow the “Quips” football team until the final days of his life.
