Josephine Meconi Arminio passed away peacefully at her Tinton Falls home on December 31st, at the age of 97. Josephine was born December 26, 1922 in Bronx, NY. She was the daughter of Esther and Egidio Meconi of Diecimo, Italy. She was married to E. Ralph Arminio from 1943 until his death in 1979. They had two sons, Robert and Richard. Josephine began her career as a primary school teacher in 1961, teaching at Saint Joseph's Catholic School in Carteret, and the Hazlet public schools. She received her Bachelor of Arts degree from Kean University in 1968. In 1972 she became the proprietor of the Noah's Ark Day Schools in Waretown and Manahawkin, NJ. She was active in the Board of Elections, the Retired Teachers Association, and implemented the first Italian American Club at her Seabrook Village residence, which amassed a membership of over 100 people. Josephine taught ceramics for many years and was an avid international traveler.

Josephine is preceded in death by her husband E. Ralph Arminio, and son Robert Arminio. She is survived by her son Richard Arminio and daughter-in-law Pat; grandchildren, Danielle Abate, Nicole Meehan, Ryan Arminio, Nikki Eyles and her husband Julian; six great-grandchildren, Cassidy Books, Emmalee Meing, Andrew Books, Olivia Abate, Nathan Eyles and Spencer Eyles, and many loving nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.
