Lois (Taylor) Stegenga, 89, passed away on Monday April 18, 2016 at Seabrook Village in Tinton Falls, NJ. She was born in York, PA and grew up in Moorestown, NJ. She was a longtime resident of North Plainfield, NJ, and also resided in Pearl River, NY, Newman, GA and Santee, SC. She became a resident of Seabrook Village since 2001.

Lois was active in the Protestant community at Seabrook Village and a devoted member of all the churches to which she belonged. While in North Plainfield, she served as a guide at the Drake House in Plainfield, helped flood victims, drove for Meals on Wheels and led a scout troop. She was involved in volunteer work in all of her places of residence. She also researched and compiled the family history in story form so that I could be passed on.

Lois was predeceased by her husband, Jack Stegenga, in 1998. She is survived by three daughters; Joan S. Eppehimer, and her husband, Wayne; Lynn S. Wheaton and her husband, Greg; Gail L. Stegenga. Lois' family also consists of four grandchildren - Taylor Wheaton, Brandon Wheaton, Joella (Eppehimer) Liddle and Julia Eppehimer; two great-grandchildren- Landon Wheaton and Aaron Wheaton and a sister, Katherine S. Taylor.

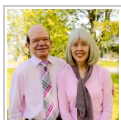

~Picking blueberries and making a pie that wouldn't set

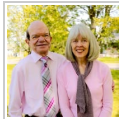
~Going to St. Simon's Island
