Marie Sottilaro Catalano, 96, of Neptune, formerly of Allenhurst and Clark, died peacefully on October 21, at Neptune Convalescent Center, Neptune. To those who knew and loved her she was known as "Nana". Marie began her career as the assistant personnel manager for Levy Brothers in Elizabeth. During the 1940's Marie was the first dispatcher for the Clark Police Department. She worked from the early 1960's until her retirement in 1983 for the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities. After her retirement Marie volunteered at Monmouth medical Center, Long Branch. On April 4, 1994 Marie was named a Kentucky Colonel by the state of Kentucky. Marie was predeceased by her husband, former Clark Police Chief, Joseph J. Catalano in 1952. In 2005 Marie lost her great grandson Anthony Wallace DeSarno and her grandson Wallace Janowski III. She was also predeceased by her sister Katherine Yuhas and her brothers Dr. Joseph, Frank and Pat Sottilaro. She is survived by her daughter Madeline Janowski of Ocean and her son Victor Catalano and his wife Mary of Bayville. Three grandchildren, Cindy J. DeSarno of Ocean, Dr. Joseph Catalano and his wife Becky of Kentucky, and Carol Pelosi and her husband Vincent. Two great grandchildren, Vincent and Victoria Pelosi.
