Marino "Joe" Milano, 71, of Tinton Falls, died Saturday May 31, at Jersey Shore University Medical Center, Neptune. Born in New York, N.Y., he has been a Monmouth County resident for the past 20 years. Joe is a graduate of La Salle Military Academy, Oakdale, NY and St. John's University, Queens. Joe served as a New York City police officer, and then he became a Federal Agent stationed in Washington D.C. for 25 years before retiring in 1986. He was also the president of EPS Navy Systems, Tinton Falls for 22 years. He was a member of the Federal Law Enforcement Officers Association, a member of the Association of Federal Narcotics Agents, and also a member of the Free and Accepted order of Masons, Archimede Roma Lodge # 0854, Balwin, N.Y..
