



Marion F. Komorowski

March 23, 1921 - January 5, 2011

Marion (Finn) Johnson Komorowski passed away on January 5, 2011. She was 89. She was raised in Nutley NJ and attended St. Mary's School and Nutley High School. Mrs. Komorowski received her BA in Education from Newark State Teachers College (now Kean University.) She completed graduate courses at Kean and Rutgers's School of Library Science, earning her certificate as a school librarian. She taught at Yantacaw and Spring Garden schools in Nutley for 23 years, retiring in 1973 to move to Stuart, Florida. Mrs. Komorowski was a member and Past President of Tri-Town Business and Professional Women's Club of Belleville, Bloomfield and Nutley and served as Treasurer of St. Mary's Rosary Society.

She returned to NJ in 1996, settling in Eatontown. She served two years as President of the Meadowbrook Resident's Association.

Mrs. Komorowski was a life member of the NJ Retired Educator's Association, NJ Education Association, Essex County Retired Teachers' Association and the National Education Association, Retired. She enjoyed travel and reading.

She is predeceased by her parents, Edward and Wilhelmina (Minnie Batchelor) Finn, her husbands, Robert Johnson and Walter Komorowski; her infant son Robert Jr., and two step-sons. She is survived by her daughter and her husband, Marion and Vincent Welsh of Eatontown, her grandson and his wife Edward and Joanna Welsh of Lodi, and their son Jacob Vincent.

Additionally, she is survived by her three step-daughters and their husbands, and numerous step-grandchildren and -great-grandchildren.
