Mark Edward Mead, 72, of Ocean, New Jersey, passed away on November 25th 2020, surrounded by family and friends.

He was born to parents Eugene and Phyllis Mead, on December 12, 1948, in Flushing Queens, NY. Mark graduated from Sheepshead Bay High School in Brooklyn and Pace University in NY.

He married Debbie, in 2002, who survives him.
