Maurice L. Henry II, 67, of Long Branch, passed away Thursday July 16, at Monmouth Medical Center, Long Branch. Born in Neptune, he grew up on Madison Ave. in Asbury Park and has been a resident of Long Branch for 40 years. He was a Customer Service Rep. for JCP&L, Allenhurst for 25 years retiring in 2005. He attended the Newark School of Fine and Industrial Arts and is known for painting "Tillie the Clown" at the Palace Amusements in Asbury Park. He was an artist, draftsman and a loving, hard working husband and father.

He is predeceased by his parents; Maurice L. Henry Sr. and Versie Mae Henry, a daughter; Ariane Henry. He is survived by his wife of 40 years Judith Henry, two sons; Maurice L. Henry III and Michael L. Henry, two sisters; Versie Henry Fairfax and Marlene Henry, a nephew; Eric L. Fairfax and his wife Andrea.

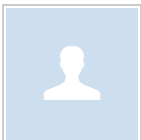
