Nadine Rose Shanahan, 87, of Eatontown, passed away peacefully on Thursday October 2, 2025. Nadine was born in Queens, NY on August 5, 1938, the second of four children born to Leo and Leonora Mangan. She graduated from the William Cullen Bryant High School in Queens, NY, and worked in New York City before meeting and marrying her husband of 53 years, Jim Shanahan, and moving to New Jersey. Nadine raised four children and while being an at-home mom got a degree from Brookdale Community College. She later worked at Fort Monmouth for 21 years before retiring in 2000.
