Robert E. Ruddy (Uncle Bob), 73, of Eatontown NJ, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on Thursday February 18, 2016 at the Jersey Shore University Medical Center, Neptune. Born and raised in Brooklyn, NY he has been a resident of Eatontown since 1969. Bob graduated from Manual Training High School ( now known as John Jay High School) in Brooklyn.
