Samuel Joseph Juliano, 80, passed away on April 12, 2020 after a heroic battle with cancer. He was born in Long Branch to his parents, Vincent and Mary Juliano. Sam met the love of his life, Laura, at the Seven Stars Dance Club in the early 60's when she asked him to join her in a lady's choice dance. 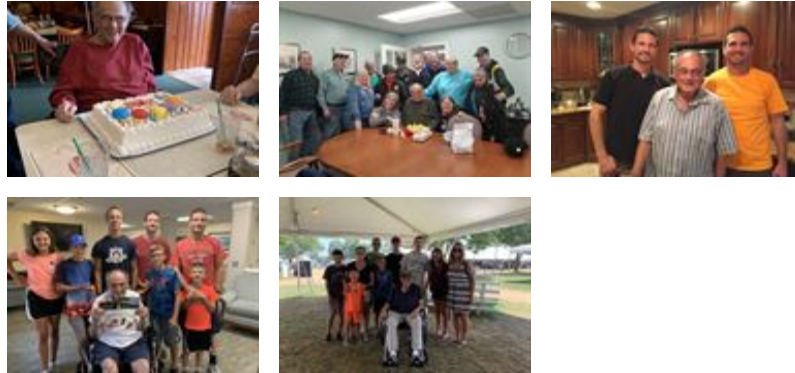
