Stephen McEntegart, 84, of Tinton Falls, passed away on Sunday August 28 2016 at Seabrook Village, Tinton Falls. He was born in Teaneck, N.J. and has lived in Holmdel, Manahawkin and has been a resident of Seabrook Village since 2014. Stephen graduated from NYU in 1950 and spent 43 years as a specialist on the NYSE gaining a seat in 1967. Upon retirement, Stephen donated his time delivering meals- on-wheels to the elderly residents of Manahawkin with his faithful dogs Murphy and Guinness riding shotgun. He and Guinness marched every year in the Belmar St. Patrick's Day parade with the Atlantic Watch & St. Brendan the Navigator Pipes & Drums. His life is a celebration of dedication to his family, the golf course (3 holes-in-one), and his dogs ("the best people I know").

He was predeceased by his parents Thomas and Phoebe McEntegart, his brothers Thomas and Gerald McEntegart. Surviving is his loving wife of 52 years, Gerry, his sister Marilyn, his two sons; Doug and Bryan, his 5 cherished grandchildren; Shannon, Connor, Kyle, Reilly and Hayden.
