Thomas Tang, 96, of Middletown, peacefully passed away at home on August 14, 2025, surrounded by his loving family. Thomas lived a rich (not in monetary terms but in experience) life. He was very proud (as are his wife and children) of his accomplishments and he will be remembered for his intelligence, courage, strength, generosity and most of all his perseverance.

Thomas was born in Shanghai, China, and immigrated to America in 1976, as a result of job transfer, settling in Matawan, NJ and then in Middletown NJ with his wife Helen and three children. He continued to work as the marketing director for American Standard for over 30 years before his retirement in September 1995.

Thomas travelled extensively to the Far East during this employment with American Standard. He developed a strong affinity for Japan and its culture and people but he also loved travelling to other places after his retirement with his wife, Helen.
