Verdelle Veronica McKinney Hill passed away Thursday, September 4, 2014 at continuing care, Seabrook Village in Tinton Falls, NJ at age 83. She was born on June 25th 1931 and was a native of Winston-Salem, North Carolina and the only child of Mrs. Naomi Witherspoon.

Verdelle attended the public schools in Winston-Salem. She received undergraduate and graduate degrees from North Carolina Central University and Columbia University, respectively. While living in New York she worked 5 years with the CETA programs as Compliance Specialist at the New York County Family Court, 4 years as Home Care Project Resource Specialist at the Community Agency for Senior Citizens (CAST) in Staten Island, 12 years as Visiting Nurse Association and Medical Social Worker retiring in 1995.

She is survived by her loving husband Glover L. Hill, Jr., her children Anita Hill of NJ, Glover L. Hill III of Fla., three grandchildren, one daughter -in-law, cousins, nieces, nephews and many cherished friends.
